

**APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE
AND PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE**

Central Bag Company applies for allowance of an administrative expense in the amount of \$39,909.19. In support of its claim, Claimant states as follows:

1. Between April 1, 2009, and April 6, 2009, Renewable Energy Holdings, Inc. ("Debtor") received goods from claimant having a value of \$39,909.19. Such goods were sold by Claimant to Debtor in the ordinary course of Debtor's business,.
2. On April 7, 2009, Aventine Renewable Energy Holdings, Inc. commenced a proceeding under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
3. On April 29, 2009, Debtor's bankruptcy case was procedurally consolidated and since that time has been jointly administered with this case.
4. On July 28, 2009, Claimant filed its Proof of Claim for the value of the goods sold by it to Debtor on or about April 1, 2009. A copy of Claimant's Proof of Claim is attached as Exhibit A.
5. Claimant's claim is an administrative claim allowable under § 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code.
6. No objection to Claimant's Proof of Claim has been made by the Debtors in this case.

For the foregoing reasons, Claimant requests that its claim in the amount of \$39,909.19 be allowed and paid as an administrative claim in accordance with provisions of the Debtor's First Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization as confirmed by this Court on February 24, 2010.



We represent Central Bag Company (the "Company") and this letter is sent on behalf of the Company concerning its reclamation rights.

Demand is hereby made for reclamation of the goods described in the invoice attached hereto (the "Goods"). The Goods are subject to reclamation pursuant to § 2-702 of the applicable Uniform Commercial Code and § 546(c) of the Bankruptcy Code.

In addition, the Debtor-in-Possession should immediately protect and segregate the Goods for the Company's benefit and the Goods must not be sold or used for any purpose. Please contact Chris Klimek at Central Bag Company to make arrangements and receive instructions for the return of the Goods. Mr. Klimek can be reached at (816) 471-0388.

Furthermore, pursuant to § 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Company hereby asserts its entitlement to an administrative priority claim for the Goods received by Debtor within the twenty (20) day period before the commencement of the bankruptcy case. The value of these Goods is \$39,909.19.

The Company's assertion of its rights herein is without prejudice to its other rights as a creditor of Debtor's bankruptcy estate including, without limitation, its right to file and seek allowance of a claim, including a claim with respect to the Goods.
